We finished out the year with our Christmas Cantata which we performed in our church and a sister church here in town. We had three first time visitors for our Christmas service and several who had not attended in a while, which was a great blessing.

One of the walls caved in due to the force of the water. This is the first time in 40 years that we had camp without a pool to cool off in. Total damage is about \$25,000 dollars.
